Researchers in Need Fellowship for the Researchers in Czech Literature Studies (Ukraine)

Institute of Czech Literature (ICL) of the Czech Academy of Sciences announces the opening of proposals for the integration of scientific researchers from Ukraine into the Researchers at Risk Fellowship program within the institute. The fellowship is offered for the positions of:

- PhD student;
- Post-doctoral researcher (PhD dissertation defense within last 8 years);
- Senior researcher.

Stays will last through 31 December 2023.

Criteria of eligibility:

- The applicant must be a citizen of Ukraine and must not hold dual citizenship, which would allow access to a safe country of residence;
- The applicant must not have resided outside Ukraine for more than one year at the time the application is submitted;
- The applicant must possess the education credentials required for the given position (and in accordance with research profile of the ICL).
